After the meeting was called to order, the first order of business was to approve the minutes of the June 13, 2006 meeting. Motion was made to approve the minutes without corrections by Commissioner Mansel, seconded by Commissioner Moore. All members present voting Aye.

Next, Mrs. Kay Bryant addressed the Commission in representation of the Jefferson/Madison Neighborhood Association. Mrs. Bryant presented the Commission with a petition of 30 signatures for request of a preservation district nomination for the Jefferson/Madison area. The proposed district will be bounded on the south by Jackson Avenue excluding houses that face Jackson with the exception of the Shaw property that runs through to North 16th Street. They are including the Shaw property at the request of the owner. On the North 16th Street running North as far as St. Andrew's Methodist Church on both the West and East sides. This will include the St. Peter's Cemetery and the Oxford Cemetery addition. The Northernmost boundary will be the end of North 14th Street including both sides of the street. The Northernmost boundary will be the end of North 14th Street including both sides of the street. On the West, the line will run just behind those houses facing North Lamar Boulevard. Both sides of Adams and Washington are included from North Lamar through to North 16th Street. After discussion, motion was made by Commissioner Manse, seconded by Commissioner Swaney to nominate the Jefferson Avenue Area as a Preservation District with the following items being supplied:

1. An official boundary map
2. Statement of Significance
3. Copies of all included parcels from the City's Historic Survey

All members present voting Aye.
