ENTRY OF APPEARANCES


Effective 01/01/2024, the Oxford Municipal Court will have two City Prosecutors. Mr. Jay Chain will continue in his capacity as City Attorney, and Mr. Robert Lomenick will start as a City Attorney.

In order to more efficiently address matters, effective immediately, the following will be implemented upon any Attorney filing an Entry of Appearance on behalf of a Defendant.

- 1) The Court will email the charging documents that it receives from the Oxford Police Department to the Attorney of Record as well as a Discovery Form for the Oxford Police Department.
- 2) The Arraignment will be continued for up to four (4) weeks unless the Attorney of Record request an earlier date, and that date is available with the Court.
- 3) On that Arraignment date, a Status Meeting will also be held with the Prosecutor(s). All Attorneys of Record **will be required to be present** for this Status Meeting to discuss their case(s) with the Prosecutor(s).
- 4) At the Status Meeting, the Attorney of Record may desire to negotiate a plea for his/her client. If so, a future plea date will be scheduled at that time.
- 5) Should a plea not be agreed upon, a trial date will be set at the time of the Status Meeting. The Court will provide a trial date to all parties. It will be incumbent on the Attorney of Record to coordinate ALL discovery and subpoena requests with the Prosecutor at that time.
