

COURT RULES

Our goal is to maintain a professional courtroom setting. Therefore, we ask for full compliance as we implement the rules of the court. We ask that everyone come well-groomed and act in a professional manner. Our dress code is business casual and the following rules apply

- No weapons are allowed in the courtroom
- No children under the age of 14 years of age allowed in the courtroom
- Absolutely no cell phones, pagers, or electronic devices are allowed in the courtroom
- Do not approach court personnel in the courtroom unless your name is called
- Excessive talking, bad attitudes, or disruptive behavior will NOT be tolerated
- No food or drinks are allowed in the courtroom
- No halter tops, tank tops, muscle shirts, or hats allowed in the courtroom
- Our court dockets can be extremely heavy so our goal is to start on time, so therefore
- We ask that you arrive on time
- No revealing clothing allowed
- No shorts or mini skirts are allowed
- No shirts with offensive writing or emblems are allowed
- Proper attire (including belts) must be worn
- No facial piercings
