

IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF OXFORD, MISSISSIPPI

SPECIAL ORDER #2

In response to the coronavirus pandemic, this state of emergency, and the emergency resolutions by the City of Oxford, further restrictive actions are required and will be immediately implemented by the Court.

Pursuant to all of the Emergency Administrative Orders by the Supreme Court of Mississippi and the Mississippi Constitution, the City of Oxford Municipal Court will remain open to ensure constitutional and statutory duties are fulfilled. However, for the next two weeks, the following restrictions and limitations will be in place:

- 1) The Court will NOT have face-to-face contact.
- 2) No proceedings, gatherings, meetings, or hearings will be held.
- 3) The Court and all interested parties will conduct business via telephone, videoconference, or facetime.
- 4) Essential matters that cannot be addressed via telephone, videoconference, or facetime will be addressed through the use of the drive-up window or the walk-up window barriers during standard working hours.
- 5) All trials remain continued until April 15, 2020.

Subsequent to this two week period, the Court will not allow meetings in excess of 10 people. The Court will avoid any proceedings involving vulnerable persons or that require witnesses or parties to travel from an infected area.
