


IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF OXFORD, MISSISSIPPI
SPECIAL ORDER #3

The Municipal Court of Oxford, Mississippi has issued two Special Orders as to the restrictions and limitations of operations during the COVID-19 pandemic. The President of the United States had declared a national emergency, and subsequently, on March 27, 2020, he signed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. This CARES Act, among other things, authorized the use of video and telephone conferencing, under certain circumstances, for various criminal matters. Additionally, following the issuance of Special Orders, this pandemic has aggressively spread around the world to include this city and county.

The prior restrictions and limitations of the Special Orders will remain in place, however, the Court finds that additional time is required to safely address all trials.

Therefore, **all scheduled trials in the Municipal Court of Oxford, Mississippi, will be continued until May 6, 2020.**
