TRAFFIC CITATION OPTIONS ONLY

- You may enter a NOT GUILTY plea. At this time, you will be given a trial date. Be advised that if you fail to appear for your trial date, you may be tried in your absence, and/or a warrant may be issued for your arrest for failure to appear.
- You can Plead GUILTY and pay the fine. No court appearance is necessary for most traffic violations. You may pay online at www.oxfordms.net. You will need your ticket number in order to access the payment portal.
- *If you are 21 years of age or older*, you may request to attend a defensive driving course to keep the ticket from affecting your driving record. In order to qualify, you must not have attended a defensive driving course in the last 3 years. There is a fee to take the course, and you are required to pay the fine in full. CDL class A or B holders are not eligible due to USDOT regulations. If you qualify and are interested in this option, please contact our office. Please note that the fine must be paid in full prior to obtaining the driving school information.
- *If you are 20 years of age or younger*, you may ask to attend a defensive driving course. In order to qualify, you must not have attended a defensive driving course in the last year. You do not have to pay the fine, but there is a fee to take the course. The ticket will be dismissed upon completion of the course and will not be reported to your driving record.
